

# COVID-19 MEASURES IN PLACE AS OF 26 NOVEMBER



**At home:** The maximum number of people that can be received at home is limited to **2**.



**Curfew:** It is prohibited to circulate in public between 23h00 and 6h00.



**Restaurants, bars and cafes:** Establishments that are serving food and drinks are closed to the public.



**Sports:** Sport facilities are closed to the public. Sport activities in groups of more than **4** people are prohibited.



**No gatherings >100 people:** Any gathering exceeding 100 people is prohibited.



**Limitation of customers per square meter:** Any commercial operation with a sales area  $\geq 400 \text{ m}^2$  is subject to a limitation of 1 customer per  $10 \text{ m}^2$ .



**Culture:** With the exception of museums, art centers, libraries and national archives, institutions of the cultural sector are closed to the public.



**Places of worship:** Establishments intended for the exercise of worship remain open, while respecting the foreseen measures of the wear of masks and distancing rules.



## WEARING A MASK IS MANDATORY:

- for activities that welcome the public
- on public transport
- for any gathering of more than **4** people, in a closed space or open air, except at home. A minimum distance of 2m must also be observed
- for any gathering from 10 and up to 100 people, the obligation of being seated while observing a minimum distance of 2m is added
